

Applications for the CSC Pacific's Bronze-level program – including renewals - should be forwarded to Triathlon BC at the end of each season. (intake deadline is December 1st for each competition year.)

The Bronze program provides a limited number of qualified athletes support and training services, including: GymWorks (free gym access at selected gyms); FoodStuff (discounts on food at selected outlets); Toolkits (Professional and Personal Development Seminars) and SportHealth (Medical Treatment & Monitoring). If you meet the requirements listed below and would like to be considered for carding, please send your race record and personal information (including TriBC #), to: info@tribc.org. Please keep in mind that the Bronze program is a system established to help the prospective Olympic athlete, and therefore, unfortunately, long course athletes (Ironman) or duathletes or not eligible.

Triathlon Bronze Level Eligibility Requirements

- Must make a commitment to attend Provincial, National, and International competitions.

AND

- Must make a commitment to work with certified coaches and/or at our National Training Facility.

PLUS ...

- Top 5 finisher in Elite Male or Female Category in the past two years at Provincial Olympic Distance Triathlon Championship.

OR

- Top 5 finisher in Elite Junior Male or Female Category in the past two years at Provincial Olympic Distance Triathlon Event. Elite Junior is defined as age 16 to 19 who participates in drafting legal Championship.

OR

- Top 20 finisher in Elite Male or Female Category in the past two years at National Olympic Distance Triathlon Championship.

OR

- Top 20 finisher in Elite Junior Male or Female Category in the past two years at National Olympic Distance Junior Triathlon Championship
