POSITION SUMMARY:

Under the direction of the Recreation Coordinator, Aquatics and the Recreation Coordinator, Fitness, the Triathlon coach develops and administers an SFU Triathlon training program that may include, but not be limited to, four one-hour training sessions per week (2 swim sessions, 1 bike session (indoor spin bikes available), 1 run session).

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must hold current Standard First Aid and CPR 'C' certifications
- Must hold a Triathlon Coaching Certificate (NCCP or equivalent)
- Must have a minimum of one year experience competing in Triathlons
- Must have a minimum of one year experience coaching participants for Triathlons
- Strong verbal communication skills
- Strong customer service skills
- Responsible and organized
- Energetic and enthusiastic

DUTIES:

- Responsible for designing, administering and evaluating the SFU Triathlon training program
- Provides continual feedback, encouragement and support to participants during the training process
- Responsible for the safety of participants in each session
- Provides training schedule for non-training days
- Available to answer participant questions as needed
- Represents Simon Fraser University in a positive, professional manner

TIME COMMITMENT:

4 hours per week plus extra support. This may include, but not be limited to, personal feedback and providing non-training day workouts.
