



## **Kelowna National Championships Senior Elite & U23 Elite Registration Process**

In order to compete in the Elite race, athletes must be approved for an International Competition Card (ICC). The ICC is TriCan's version of an 'elite' card. Once approved, athletes are eligible to compete in ITU Continental/Pan Am Cup Series events. The Kelowna elite race, is a Pan Am Cup race, so every athlete has to be approved for the ICC in advance to be eligible, no exceptions.

Once approved for an International Competition Card, all athletes must be entered in the ITU registration system prior to the race. To register, please have them contact me at [raceentries@triathloncanada.com](mailto:raceentries@triathloncanada.com). If they've been approved for an ICC, all they need to do is let me know that they would like to race in Kelowna and I will enter them with the ITU. If they haven't been approved, I can't enter them until they are.

Senior Elite Athletes DO NOT have to register on the Apple Triathlon website with the Local Organizing Committee. They only have to register through Triathlon Canada, and there is no entry fee this year for the elite race.

The eligibility and registration procedure also applies to all Under-23 athletes, as they compete with the Senior Elites in the Pan Am Cup race.
