

2019 RACE INFORMATION SHEET

'Sanctioned by Triathlon BC' is a designation that indicates an event has met the minimum requirements established by Triathlon BC for safety and fairness at a competition. It signifies that a Race Director has completed a thorough review of an event's swim, bike and run courses, has evaluated and planned for medical, emergency, safety and volunteer support, and that the Race Director will conduct the event according to the rules and regulations governed by the International Triathlon Union (ITU), Triathlon Canada and Triathlon BC.

The information supplied below will appear on the Triathlon BC website race calendar, please double check all information for accuracy.

- Events that do not have a recent* Triathlon BC sanction history are required to submit a letter of endorsement, issued by the host municipality they wish to run an event in. Each letter must indicate the name of the organizer, proposed date and location of the event, and be signed by the permit issuing department of the host community. A letter of endorsement must accompany each Race Bid (*5 or more years).
- Additionally, at the discretion of the Triathlon BC Board, a refundable deposit of up to \$2,500.00 may be requested to ensure sanctioning procedures are followed.
- All outstanding fees must be resolved prior to submitting this form. Events with outstanding event fees will not be candidates for sanctioned status.

In 2017, Triathlon BC joined Triathlon Canada's National Triathlon Registration System (NTRS), a common database shared with triathlon governing bodies across Canada. Based out of North Vancouver, the NTRS streamlines membership verification, allows for one-event membership sales, and includes Triathlon BC post event accounting. It can also handle event registration, and offers a high degree of quantitative analysis to its clients. Are you interested in joining the NTRS?
