



COMMITMENT TO FAIR PLAY

A. Background & Purpose

Triathlon BC's policy of Fair Play promotes the principles of *respect, responsibility* and *integrity*. The purpose of this document is to clearly inform athletes, coaches, race directors, officials, staff, volunteers, spectators and all Triathlon BC members of its position on Fair Play.

B. Respect

The principle of respect is to treat all participants with respect at all times, and that all participants of Triathlon BC sanctioned events are in the sport for enjoyment, and should not be intimidated from participation in the sport. All participants will respect and play by the Laws of the sport, as defined and explained by Triathlon BC, Triathlon Canada and the International Triathlon Union (ITU).

C. Responsibility

That all participants will act in a responsible, respectful, inclusive and safe manner in any activities sanctioned by Triathlon BC.

D. Integrity

All participants are expected to be honest, sincere and honorable in their relationships with other participants. That coaches and officials will demonstrate and promote the value of sport for individuals, teams and society in general, act to ensure the sporting environment is inclusive and will encourage all participants to continue their involvement in the sport. This policy covers all Triathlon BC members, coaching staff, administration staff and others associated with any Triathlon BC operations.

E. Review and Approval

This policy shall be reviewed by Triathlon BC Board and Staff on a regular basis.
