

2022 RACE INFORMATION SHEET - COVID 19

The COVID-19 Pandemic has hit the endurance event marketplace hard. In 2020, 97% of our regularly sanctioned events were cancelled in our province. The tail end of the 2021 season saw a small uptick in event hosting. Triathlon BC understands the challenges and hardships local event organizers have faced over the past two season, and empathize with every Race Director and LOC as they navigate the COVID-19 landscape.

As we move towards the 2022 season, Triathlon BC is hopeful that multisport events will return in a modified format, always respecting the Provincial Health Office orders while meeting the needs of enthusiastic participants across province.

2022 Provincial Championships are now up for hosting bids. Designated Championship events include:

- BC Aquathlon Championships
- BC Duathlon Championships
- BC Junior & U23 Triathlon Championships (must be Draft Legal)
- BC Cross Triathlon Championships
- BC Sprint Distance Triathlon Championships
- BC Standard Distance Triathlon Championships
- BC Long Distance Championships

Note 1: The Provincial Health Office mandates may restrict travel. If restrictions are province-wide, Provincial Titles may also be restricted.

LIABILITY PROTECTION ANNOUNCEMENT: The Province has now acted to extend COVID-19 liability coverage to FOR-PROFIT ORGANIZATIONS through the COVID-19 Related Measures Act (CRMA). The regulation protects people (paid or volunteer) from proceedings for civil liability for damages resulting from transmission or exposure to the virus that causes COVID-19. The regulation is retroactive to January 1, 2020 and will remain in force unless and until the CRMA is repealed. This addresses the liability concerns of for-profit race directors and LOCs.
